

Mentors are needed to lead students in the design and development of a response to a question over the course of a hackathon event. This includes a set of deliverables and a final presentation given to the group. The hackathon will schedule daily check-ins during which brief updates will need to be given.

Prior to the event: Two hours of prep and overview time to generate a question/project which the participants could select to address as well as time for two brief conference calls with other mentors, supporting staff, participants, and the organizing committee.

During the event: Minimum of four hours daily be allotted in assisting the group. Communication is vital to the success of any team and hackathons (especially in a virtual format) need dedicated time to ensure team success.
